AIR MARSHAL SUBROTO MUKERJEE MEMORIAL ORATION



Air Marshal Subroto Mukerjee OBE was amongst the first batch of Indian officers to pass out of Cranwell and to be granted the Kings commission in the Royal Indian Air Force in 1932. He went on to be-

come the first Indian Chief of the Indian Air force in 1954. He took an active interest in the medical services as well and became the patron of the Aeromedical Society in the year 1954. To acknowledge the contribution of this outstanding leader, the Society established the Air Marshal Subroto Mukerjee medal and oration in 1971.
